MARTINSBURG - A decision has been made to discontinue life support for Christian Lanciano, 22, who has been in City Hospital's intensive care unit since it was discovered that he had overdosed on heroin last week

Local attorney Paul Taylor, who has been representing the family, said Friday afternoon that Lanciano's mother, Angela Lanciano Moreno, is now satisfied that all of the appropriate medical tests have been done to determine his true physical condition.

"Unfortunately, at this time there is no good news," Taylor said.

Moreno initially disagreed with doctors, who had "prematurely determined that her son was brain dead and had no hope of recovery," she said in an earlier interview.

At that point, Moreno said the family was encouraged because Lanciano had moved his eye lids and squeezed her hand.

Hoping to gain some additional time, Moreno successfully went to court Monday to obtain a temporary restraining order.

At that time, Berkeley County Circuit Judge Gina Groh granted a 10-day restraining order.

But on Friday, Moreno asked Taylor to file paperwork at the courthouse to officially dissolve that order, Taylor said.

"These most recent tests have shown there is no brain activity," Taylor said.

Lanciano also was unable to breath on his on after the ventilator was turned off, he said.

"The hospital is now free to do what it has to do," Taylor said.

Taylor believes that will be coordinated with Moreno, so that "she can be present when the machines are disconnected. She obviously wants to be there when that happens," he said.

He did not know when that step might be taken.

After watching this drama unfold. Taylor said it has been heartbreaking even though he is not a family member.

It should also send a message to others, who should learn from this family's pain, Taylor said.

"Young people, don't get involved in drugs. Don't ruin your lives. Don't break your parent's hearts," he
